### 13 CHESHIRE BICKERTON HILL & RAW HEAD

Distance: 6½ miles/10.5km Time: 4 hours Grade: Moderate





## CHOSEN BY... STEVE GOODIER West Cheshire's sandstone ridge rises

above the county's central plain offering great walking country with wooded heights and unexpected (and dramatic) viewpoints. The Sandstone Trail Footpath follows the ridgeline and a good path network make this a great place for a walk. Our route is an energetic circuit of Maiden Castle, Bickerton Hill and Raw Head – the highest point in West Cheshire at 745ft/227m.

#### **Start**

At the end of Coppermines Lane go L ('Sandstone Trail – Raw Head/Whitchurch')

at junction. Follow the track leaving it to go half L through kissing gate on the Sandstone Trail further on, Follow path through woods forking half R at marker dropping through woods and crossing stile to track. Go L following track through gate/opening/stile. Keep ahead to reach lane. Shortly go R at the path crossroads. Descend steps going R at track junction. Go Immediately L over stile. Descend steps curving R under house. Continue into woodland via kissing gate. Pass through woods exiting via gates to 'Harthill' entrance. Go L descending path curving L/R descending by fence. Pass through gate continuing ahead to road in Harthill.



Cross over going R then
L rising keeping L of Church.
Pass through gate/stile taking
track through buildings to pass

crossing stile/gate. Continue ahead by wood L curving L around hillside. Follow line of electric fence descending over stile. Descend L edge next field crossing stile L near bushes. Go half R crossing three stiles and a bridge to follow path up field through kissing gate to A534.

**2**½ miles/3.6km Cross road going L then R at next junction for 'Brown Knowl' taking Simthy Lane. Follow lane passing Church. When lane bends R take I ower Sandy Lane L going R at lane end. Rise going L by house. At next fork stay R (ahead) curving L at next fork (main track). Go ahead through gate when track bends R. Rise up track going L at junction (two posts). At next junction go ahead rising over heath. At next junction cut L descend to multi path junction/sign. Go half R (path R of Sandstone Trail) rising to junction on escarpment edge. Go L following path along hillside. Join Sandstone Trail going ahead up steps to go L at path crossroads. Follow Sandstone Trail over Maiden Castle to descend track/steps to junction of paths. Go ahead (Sandstone Trail) continuing ahead at next iunction. At aully head go L for 'Raw Head/Beeston'. Continue to stone on summit.

41/4 miles/6.8km Follow the Sandstone Trail ahead descending the hillside



passing through the kissing gate. Follow path through kissing gate. At lane go L going ahead at crossroads. Rise to A534. Cross half L (Sandstone Trail) taking the lane uphill. Stay ahead after Walnut Cottage following the track to curve L. Pass through kissing gate at end of surfaced track. Rise on the path following Sandstone Trail rising and dropping using steps where available. At the viewpoint L continue to drop again passing the viewpoint. Pass the fence L by a steep drop. Follow the path/Sandstone Trail rising up steep steps further up. Follow Sandstone Trail to summit Raw Head.

5½ miles/8.85km Go R following the Sandstone Trail by the wall and later a fence to descend the hillside. After some rises/ falls continue ahead ignoring any turnings off to pass outcrops. Descend to pick up the outbound route at the marker. Follow the Sandstone Trail through kissing gate going R on track to Coppermines Lane. CW
